**1. Required Qualification for Associate Professor in School of Law, Forensic Justice & Policy Studies:**

- (i) A good academic record.
- (ii) Ph.D. in relevant discipline with first class or equivalent (minimum 55 % or equivalent) at the preceding degree i.e. Master degree in law from a recognized University or equivalent with a very good academic record throughout.
- (iii) Minimum five publications in the Peer Reviewed or UGC listed Journals.
- (iv) A minimum eight years of experience in teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of an Assistant Professor in a University, College, or Accredited Research Institution/industry.

**Desirable:** Candidate having experience in the field of Cyber and Information technology Law, Criminal Law, Corporate and Commercial Law, Alternative Dispute Resolution Functional Area: Legal Research, Moot court, Drafting and Pleading, Legal Aid and relevant fields and experience with Ph.D. Guidance will be preferred.

**2. Required Essential Qualification/eligibility for Associate Professor in School of Cyber Security & Digital Forensics (as per AICTE guidelines):**

- (i) A good academic record.
- (ii) Ph.D. Degree in relevant field and minimum first class (60%) or equivalent at either Bachelor's or Master's level in the relevant branch.
- (iii) At least total 06 research publications in the SCI journals/UGC/AICTE approved list of Journals.
- (iv) A minimum eight years of experience in teaching/research/industry out of which at least 2 years shall be post Ph.D. experience.

**Desirable:** Candidate having experience in the field of IT/Cyber Security/AI/Data Science/ Digital Forensics I Network Security/ Network Forensics/Quantum Computing etc., or relevant domain and experience with Ph.D. Guidance will be preferred.

**3. Required Essential Qualification/eligibility for Assistant Professor in School of Cyber Security & Digital Forensics (as per AICTE guidelines):**

- (i) B.E. / B.Tech. / B.S. and M.E. / M. Tech. / M.S. in the relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

**Desirable:** (i) Candidate having Ph.D. in the relevant fields will be preferred.

(ii) Candidate having one year experience as assistant professor or industry in the field of IT/Cyber Security/AI/Data Science/ Digital Forensics/ Network Security/ Network Forensics/Quantum Computing etc., or relevant domain will be preferred.

(iii) Candidate having NET/GATE will be preferred.

**4. Required Qualification for Assistant Professor in School of Law, Forensic Justice & Policy Studies:**

- (i) Master Degree in Law with 60% marks or above or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed, from a recognized University, along with a good academic record in the Domains/Fields mentioned above.
- (ii) The Ph.D. Degree in a concerned/ relevant/ allied subjects is mandatory.
- (iii) The candidate with the National Eligibility Test (NET) or a similar test accredited by the UGC will be preferred.
- (iv) Research publications in the peer reviewed journals will be preferred.

**5. Required Qualification for Teaching Associate in School of Law, Forensic Justice & Policy Studies:**

- (i) Master Degree in specified Domains/Fields mentioned above with 60% marks or above or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed, from a recognized University, along with a good academic record.  
(ii) The candidate with the National Eligibility Test (NET) or a similar test accredited by the UGC is mandatory.  
(iii) The Ph.D. Degree/JRF in a concerned/ relevant/ allied subjects will be preferred.  
(iv) Research publications in the peer reviewed journals will be preferred.  
(v) Candidates possessing granted patents or published patent applications in the relevant field shall be given additional weightage/preference.

**7. Required Qualification for Teaching Associate in School of Cyber Security & Digital Forensics:**


- (i) B.E. / B.Tech. / B.S. and M.E. / M. Tech. / M.S. in the relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

**Desirable:** (i) Candidate having teaching/ industry experience in the field of IT/Cyber Security/AI/Data Science/ Digital Forensics/ Network Security/ Network Forensics/Quantum Computing etc., or relevant domain will be preferred.

- (ii) Candidate having NET/GATE will be preferred.

**General Terms/ Instructions**

1. The filling up of the post of **Associate Professor/Assistant Professor/ Teaching Associate** shall be on need basis and purely temporary & Contractual.
2. The selected candidates against the post of **Associate Professor/Assistant Professor** will be paid as per **UGC/AICTE pay scale (Basic +DA consolidated)**.
3. The selected candidates against the post of **Teaching Associate** will be paid Rs 57,700/- per month consolidated. No other benefits of any kind including HRA etc. will be paid.
4. The medium of instructions with respect to all courses conducted in all Schools shall be in English.
5. *The candidate will be required to produce all original documents relating to educational qualifications, experience, and other essential requirements, etc. in original at the time of the interview, failing which, his/her candidature stands cancelled.*
6. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
